FORMULA 1 SINGAPORE AIRLINES SINGAPORE GRAND PRIX 2024

As the season draws near, the world's fastest drivers will race under bright lights at speeds of up to 325km/h at the Formula 1 Singapore Airlines Singapore Grand Prix 2024 happening from 20 to 22 September. The backdrop of this exhilarating night race is the stunning Marina Bay Street Circuit set against Singapore's skyline and iconic landmarks such as the Merlion, Singapore Flyer and National Gallery Singapore. The high-octane weekend will also include the Porsche Carrera Cup Asia, where drivers compete in Pro and Pro-Am classes, and the Singapore debut of the all-female series F1 AcademyTM.

The stellar entertainment line-up includes Grammy winner Kylie Minogue, Rock and Roll Hall of Famer Lenny Kravitz, and chart-topping band OneRepublic. You can view the entertainment line-up here.



TIPS FOR AN AMAZING GPSS IN SINGAPORE

From 13 to 22 September, gear up for an amazing Grand Prix Season Singapore. Here are our top tips to best navigate the city and enjoy the festivities – all while revelling in the adrenaline rush that the Singapore night race brings.

Zip around with public transport

Ditch the car and hop on Singapore's super-efficient MRT or bus system. Public transport is the way to go during GPSS. Taxis and ride-hailing services like Grab and Gojek are also available but may be in high demand during peak times, plus, they'll need to navigate road closures.

Avoid road closures

With that in mind, it pays to be aware of road closures and diversions around the city. Plan your route ahead of time, and make sure to head down to the events early. Road closures are around the Marina Bay Street Circuit, including Bayfront Avenue, Collyer Quay, Stamford Road, Republic Boulevard, and Esplanade Drive. Stay cool and hydrated

As a tropical island, Singapore is known for being hot and humid. Wear light, breathable clothing, slap on some sunscreen, and keep a water bottle handy to stay refreshed. Convenience stores and water dispensers (typically found at attractions) are scattered throughout the city – make good use of them!

In case of emergencies, dial 999 for police or 995 for an ambulance. Save these numbers in your phone so you're always prepared.
